When the apostles returned, they reported to Jesus what they had done. Then he took them with him and they withdrew by themselves to a town called Bethsaida. Luke 9:10

Jesus wanted to help his friends take a break from their work and just have a little fun. He knew they needed to recharge their batteries and get away from their day-to-day lives for a bit. He knew they needed some fun. So away they went.

With summer upon us, I hope you have some time set aside to have fun. Fun is important. Play is important. Without those times of fun and play, we have nothing but the mundane to look forward to. So, the question I have for you is, when was the last time you had fun? I don't mean playing a board game or something like that. I mean really let go and did something that truly brought you joy. Something where when you finished, you thought or said, "I needed that!" I hope you will take some time in the coming days, and have fun!
