"Today - Tomorrow - Together"

I'm writing this Sunday afternoon after a great day of praise and worship, and I'm getting used to our increased average attendance (123 so far this year, up from 109 last year) and the wonderful Spirit of God in our midst. While there are so many great things going on in the life of NMUMC, I also want to update you on the results (thus far) of our "Today – Tomorrow – Together" Campaign to pay off the debt for our new HVAC equipment.

For the past month or more I have been encouraging you to consider how you might participate in our effort to make these necessary updates to our building. Our Board took on just over \$115,000 in debt to pay for the new HVAC systems. The equipment and installation of the new equipment totaled just under \$100,000, and the additional money was borrowed to cover the electrical work required to operate these new units (this is in addition to the electrical work we had done in February after our electrical fire). We have been on the lookout for grants and rebates available through a variety of sources and anticipate at least \$3,000 from that.

Earlier this week I asked our Administrative Board to submit their pledges or gifts ahead of time, and they led the way for our congregation. 9 pledges or gifts were received from our leadership (that's everyone involved on the Board) totaling approximately \$40,000. Today the rest of the congregation made their commitments, and wow - another \$52,000 was pledged or given! I have already heard from several who were unable to be in worship today or were unable to submit their commitment today, but who also plan to participate in this effort. This leaves me very optimistic that not only will we achieve our goal of getting debt free (again) by the end of 2024, but that we might receive additional funds to help with some of the other deferred maintenance projects to continue the preservation of our beautiful and historic building! (Update: As of noon May 1, we have broken the \$100,000 barrier!)

On behalf of the Administrative Board, I want to say THANK YOU for your generosity and support of the mission and ministries of Nelson Memorial UMC! As a friend of mine who works with lots of churches working to make a difference in their community likes to say — "The best is yet to come!" God has some important work ahead for us, and I can't wait to get to it. Thank you for all that you do as part of the Body of Christ.
